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
Notes

- The patterns in this eBook are for 6 different blankets that are worked without a long starting chain, for stress-free crocheting!
- You will find patterns of each method: Corner to Corner, Middle Out, and a Mitered square. In each method you can work the blanket as big as you'd like.

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Across the Way C2C Baby Blanket

Skill Level: easy

Materials

- Crochet hook size: 4.5 mm
- Worsted (#4) weight yarn (50gr -100m/109yds) - I used <u>Knit Picks - Comfy</u> <u>Worsted</u>
 - Amount of yarn needed: Color A - 150gr/300m/327yds Color B – 350gr/700m/763yds Color C - 150gr/300m/327yds
- 2 stitch markers

<u>Gauge:</u> 16 sc and 16 rows = 4 in/10 cm with 4.5mm hook (gauge is not crucial)

Finished size: 30x35 in (76x89 cm)

Abbreviations (US)

PM - place marker
ch - chain
yo - yarn over
sc - single crochet
sc2tog - single crochet 2 together
dc - double crochet
dc2tog - double crochet 2 together
dc-cl - <u>dc cluster stitch</u>: yo, insert hook
into indicated st, yo and pull up a loop,
pull yarn through 2 loops. yo, insert
hook into same st, yo and pull up a loop,
pull yarn through 2 loops. Pull yarn
through 3 loops.
* This st is basically dc2tog where the 2

dc are worked into the same st.

Pattern Notes

- The blanket is worked from corner to corner as a rectangle.
- To make it easier to find the ch3 / ch2 spaces at the end of the row, place a stitch marker when you ch3/ch2 at the beginning of each row.



ch4

Row 1: [1sc, 1dc-cl] in 4th ch from hook, turn.



Row 2: ch3-PM, 1sc in 1st dc-cl, 1dc-cl in next sc, [1sc, 1dc] in ch-3, turn.




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Row 3: ch3-PM, 1sc in 1st dc, 1dc-cl in next sc.

* 1sc in next dc-cl, 1dc-cl in next sc; repeat from * to ch-3, [1sc, 1dc] in ch-3, turn.



Rows 4-33: Work row 3 (or until the side of the triangle measures 15in (38cm)).

<u>With color B</u>

Row 34: Work row 3.

With color A

Rows 35-37: Work row 3.

With color B

Row 38-39: Work row 3.

With color A

Rows 40-41: Work row 3.

With color B

Row 42-44: Work row 3.

With color A

Row 45: Work row 3.



With color B

Rows 46-66: Work row 3 (or until the side of the triangle measures 30in (76cm)).



Start decreasing on one side:

Row 67: ch2-PM, skip next dc & sc.

* 1sc in next dc-cl, 1dc-cl in next sc; repeat from * to ch-3, [1sc, 1dc] in ch-3, turn.





Row 68: ch3-PM, 1sc in 1st dc.
* 1dc-cl in next sc, 1sc in next dc-cl; repeat from * to
last sc, dc2tog in last sc & ch-2, turn.



Row 69: ch2-PM, skip next dc2tog & sc.

* 1sc in next dc-cl, 1dc-cl in next sc; repeat from * to ch-3, [1sc, 1dc] in ch-3, turn.

Rows 70-77: Work rows 68-69 (Or until the long side of the blanket- the side you keep increasing, measures 35in (89cm)).



Start decreasing on both sides:

Row 78: ch2-PM, skip next dc & sc, 1sc in next dc-cl.

* 1dc-cl in next sc, 1sc in next dc-cl; repeat from * to last sc, dc2tog in last sc & ch-2, turn.



Row 79: ch2-PM, skip next dc2tog & sc, 1sc in next dc-cl.
* 1dc-cl in next sc, 1sc in next dc-cl; repeat from * to last sc, dc2tog in last sc & ch-2, turn.



Rows 80-98: Work row 79. (Or until the longer side of the decrease- the side you started

decreasing first, measures 15in (38cm)).

With color C

Row 99: Work row 79.

With color B

Rows 100-102: Work row 79.

With color C

Rows 103-104: Work row 79.

With color B

Rows 105-106: Work row 79.

With color C

Row 107-109: Work row 79.

With color B

Rows 110: Work row 79.

With color C


Row 111-141: Work row 79 (or until you have only 1 cluster stitch in your row (total of 4

sts + ch2).

Row 142: ch**2**-PM, skip next dc2tog & sc, 1sc in next dccl, dc2tog in last sc & ch-2, turn.

Row 143: ch**1**, skip next dc2tog, sc2tog in next sc & ch-2. Fasten off.

Weave in the ends. Soak and block if needed.





Ella's Lullaby Baby Blanket



Skill Level: intermediate

<u>Materials</u>

- Crochet hook size: G-6 / 4 mm
- DK / Light weight yarn (100gr -212m/232yd):
 Color A- 500gr - 1,060m/1,160yd
 Color B- 100gr - 212m/232yd
 (I used Lion Brand – Coboo, color A- Ice blue, color B- Tan)
- 4 stitch markers

<u>Gauge:</u> Working rounds 1-5 will result in a 4x4" (10x10 cm) square

Finished size: 31.5x31.5 in (80x80 cm)

Abbreviations (US)

- ch chain
- ss slip stitch
- ss blo slip stitch in back loop only
- sc single crochet
- sc blo single crochet in back loop only
- dc double crochet
- D-V double V stitch [2dc, ch1, 2dc] in same stitch
- **PM** place markers

With color A

Make a magic ring.


Round 1: ch1, (1sc, ch2) x4 into magic ring, ss to 1st sc. Pull the ring tight. (4sc + 8ch)
Round 2: ss into ch-2, ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc] in ch-2, ch2, skip sc.
* 1D-V in next ch-2, ch2, skip sc; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (16dc + 12ch)



Round 3: ss in the next 4 sts and into the ch-2 gap, ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch3, 2dc] in same ch-2 (corner), 1D-V in next ch-1.

* [2dc, ch3, 2dc] in next ch-2 (corner), 1D-V in next ch-1; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3.


(32dc + 16ch)



Round 4: ss in the next st and into the ch-3 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc, ch1- **PM**, 1D-V] all in next ch-3, 1D-V in next ch-1.

* [1D-V, ch1- **PM**, 1D-V] in next ch-3 (corner), 1D-V in next ch-1; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (48dc + 16ch)

** Put markers at the ch-1 corners.



Round 5: ss in the next 4 sts and into the ch-1 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch3-PM,

2dc] in ch-1 (corner), (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until marker (ch-1 corner).

* [2dc, ch3-**PM**, 2dc] in next ch-1 (corner), (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until marker (ch-1 corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (64dc + 24ch)

** Move markers to the corners in each round, to avoid skipping the corners.



Round 6: 1ss in the next st and into the ch-3 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc, ch1- PM, 1D-V] in ch-3, (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until ch-3 (corner).
* [1D-V, ch1-PM, 1D-V] in next ch-3 (corner), (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until ch-3 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (80dc + 24ch)

Round 7: 1ss in the next 4 sts and into the ch-1 (corner), ch1- **PM** (counts as ss blo), 1ss blo in each st (each dc and ch-1) until marker.

* 1ss blo in ch-1 (corner)- PM, 1ss blo in each st (each dc and ch-1) until marker; Repeat

from * 2 more times. Ss to 1st ch-1 (corner). (104 ss blo)

** last 5 ss blo of this round will be in 5 ss (1 of previous round and 4 ss of beginning of this round).



When changing colors:

At the last stitch of the round, before changing color, start the stitch as normal, when you pull the yarn through the loop to finish the stitch, **wrap the new color around the hook and pull through**.



With color B

Round 8: ch1 (doesn't count as sc), 3sc blo in same 1st st (corner) - PM in the 2nd sc blo, 1sc blo in each st until marker.

* 3sc blo in ss blo (corner) - **PM in the 2nd sc blo**, 1sc blo in each st until marker; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to 1st **sc blo**. (112 sc blo)



With color A

Round 9: ch1 (**counts as 1sc blo**), ch3- **PM**, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before marker, 2sc blo in next st.

* Ch3- **PM**, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before marker, 2sc blo in next st; Repeat from * 1 more time.

Ch3- **PM**, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before ch-4, 2sc blo in next st, ss to 1st ch-1. (116 sc blo + 12ch)



With color B

Round 10: 1ss into ch-3 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc, ch1-**PM**, 1D-V] in ch-3, (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4 sts before ch-3 (corner).

* [1D-V, ch1- PM, 1D-V] in next ch-3 (corner), (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4

sts before ch-3 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3 and in next 4 sts and into ch-1 - corner. (112dc + 32ch)



With color A

Round 11: ch1- PM (counts as ss blo), 1ss blo in each st (each dc and ch-1) until marker.
* 1ss blo in ch-1 (corner)- PM, 1ss blo in each st (each dc and ch-1) until marker; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to 1st ch-1. (144 ss blo)

** last 5 ss blo for this round will be in 5 ss of previous round.

With color B

Round 12 (same as round 8): ch1 (doesn't count as sc), 3sc blo in same 1st st (corner) - PM in the 2nd sc blo, 1sc blo in each st until marker.

* 3sc blo in ss blo (corner) - PM in the 2nd sc blo, 1sc blo in each st until marker; Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to 1st sc blo. (152 sc blo)

With color A

Round 13 (same as round 9): ch1 (counts as sc blo), ch3- PM, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before marker, 2sc blo in next st.

* Ch3- **PM**, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before marker, 2sc blo in next st; Repeat from * 1 more time.

Ch3- **PM**, skip next sc blo (corner), 2sc blo in next st, 1sc blo in each st until 1 st before ch-4, 2sc blo in next st, ss to 1st ch-1. (156 sc blo + 12ch)

Round 14: ss into ch-3 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc, ch1-**PM**, 1D-V] in ch-3, (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4 sts before ch-3 (corner).

* [1D-V, ch1- **PM**, 1D-V] in next ch-3 (corner), (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4 sts before ch-3 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (144dc + 40ch)


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
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Round 15: repeat round 5. (160dc + 48ch) Round 16: repeat round 6. (176dc + 48ch) Round 17: repeat round 5. (192dc + 56ch)

Round 18: 1ss in the next st and into the ch-3 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 2dc, ch1- PM, 1D-V] in ch-3, (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until ch-3 (corner).
* [1D-V, ch1-PM, 1D-V] in next ch-3 (corner), (1D-V in next ch-1) repeat (...) until ch-3 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. 1ss in the next 4 sts. (208dc + 56ch)

With color B

Round 20: In this round, work all D-V stitches through the back loops of both rounds 18 & 19 together.



1ss into ch-2 (corner), ch3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch4- PM, 2dc] in ch-2 (corner), skip 2 sts, 1D-V in next st, (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 2 sts before ch-2 (corner). * [2dc, ch4- PM, 2dc] in next ch-2 (corner), skip 2 sts, 1D-V in next st, (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 2 sts before ch-2 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3, 1ss into next st. (224dc + 68ch)

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With color B


Round 21: * ch3- **PM** (corner), skip ch-4, 1ss blo in each st (each dc and ch-1) until ch-4 (corner); Repeat from * 3 more times. Ss to 1st ch in corner. (276 ss blo + 12ch)

With color A

Round 22: In this round, work all D-V stitches through the back loops of both rounds 21 & 20 together.

1ss into ch-4 of round 20 (pic 1), ch-3 (counts as 1dc), [1dc, ch1, 1dc] into ch-4 of round 20 (pic 2), [1dc, ch1- **PM**, 1dc] in **both** back loop of the 2nd ch of round 21 corner and into ch-4 of round 20 (into ch-4, not a specific ch) (pics 3+4), [1dc, ch1, 2dc] into ch-4 of round 20 (pic 5), (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4 sts before ch-3 (corner).

* [2dc, ch1, 1dc] into ch-4 of round 20, [1dc, ch1- **PM**, 1dc] in **both** back loop of the 2nd ch of round 21 corner and into ch-4 of round 20 (into ch-4, not a specific ch), [1dc, ch1, 2dc] into ch-4 of round 20, (skip 4 sts, 1D-V in next st) repeat (...) until 4 sts before ch-3 (corner); Repeat from * 2 more times. Ss to top of ch-3. (240dc + 64ch)



Round 23: repeat round 5. (256dc + 72ch) Round 24: repeat round 6. (272dc + 72ch) Round 25: repeat round 5. (288dc + 80ch) Round 26: repeat round 6. (304dc + 80ch)

** From this point you will repeat some of the previous rounds, ignoring the previously stated sts numbers which will now be larger.

Rounds 27-46: Work rounds **7-26 Rounds 47-56:** Work rounds **7-16**

Yay you're done!

Bind off.

Wash the blanket (hand wash or gentle cycle program) and block it.

Mitered Butterflies Baby Blanket



Level: Intermediate

Materials

- Crochet hook size: 4.5 mm
- Worsted (#4) weight yarn
 (I used <u>Knit Picks Comfy Worsted</u>)
 <u>Total amount of yarn needed:</u>
 Color A 550 grams/1,100m/1,199yds
 Color B 50 grams/100m/109yds
 Color C 50 grams/100m/109yds
- 1 stitch marker (optional)

<u>Gauge:</u> Working rows 1-3 will result in an approx. 2.5" (6.3 cm) wide square.

Finished size: 36x36" (92x92cm)

Abbreviations (US)

ch - chain

- **C-puff2** <u>crossed puff2</u>: (yo, insert hook into skipped st, yo and pull up a loop in a diagonal to the height of the dc's) x 2 times, yo and pull through all **5** loops.
- dc double crochet
- flo work in front loop only
- PM place markers
- sc single crochet
- st stitch
- **STsc** <u>stacked single crochet</u>: work 1 single crochet in the first stitch, then work another single crochet into the left leg of the single crochet you just worked.
- tr treble crochet
- yo yarn over

Special Stitches

How to crochet the Stacked Single Crochet (STsc): This stitch is an alternative to double crochet, its intention in this pattern is to replace the ch3, or ch2 + dc at the beginning of the pattern and get a straighter edge.

At the beginning of the row, do not chain, keep your yarn behind your hook and work 1 single crochet in the first stitch, then work another single crochet into the left leg of the single crochet you just worked.



How to crochet the C-puff2 (Crossed puff2):

(yo, insert hook into skipped st, yo and pull up a loop in a diagonal to the height of the dc's) x 2 times, yo and pull through all **5** loops.



Pattern Notes

- There is a stitch count table after the written instructions.
- The blanket is worked in the Mitered method from one corner to corner (similar to the C2C method, but without the decreasing), you can make it as big as you'd like.
- Place marker in the corner stitch (tr) and move marker along the rows to make it easier to find the corner.
- To help with stitch count: every row adds 4 stitches (2 in each side).
- STsc is an alternative to the 1st double crochet, its intention in this pattern is to get a straighter edge. If you prefer, you can replace it with ch3, or ch2 + dc at the beginning of each row.
- After working the C-puff2, make sure to crochet the dc into the next dc and not the last one you've worked into.
- When changing color: at the last stitch of the row, before changing color, start the stitch as normal, before you pull the yarn through the 2 loops to finish the stitch, wrap the new color around the hook and then pull through.



To make it easier to follow the pattern, I have divided the blanket into sections as follows:



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Pattern

You can find a <u>video tutorial</u> to show you how to start a mitered square <u>HERE</u>. Use this video for rows 1-3 in this pattern.

With color A

Make a magic ring.

Row 1 (WS): Ch4 (counts as 1tr), working into the ring: 3dc, (1tr, 3dc) x3 times, ss to top of ch-4. Pull the ring tight, turn. (12 dc, 4 tr)

Row 2 (RS): STsc (counts as 1dc here and throughout) in 1st tr, 1dc in next 3 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1dc in next tr, turn. (12 dc, 1 tr)

Row 3 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next 5 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in next 6 dc, turn. (16 dc, 1 tr)

* To meet gauge, make sure the length in the center of the square is approx. 2.5in/6.3cm.



Row 4 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next 2 dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in next dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, turn. (18 dc, 1 tr, 2 C-puff2)

** After working the C-puff2, make sure to crochet the dc into the next dc and not the last



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one you've worked into. **Row 5 (WS):** STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 4 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in next **2** dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 4 dc, turn. (22 dc, 1 tr, 2 C-puff2)



Row 6 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in each st until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in each st to the end of the row, turn. (28 dc, 1 tr)

Row 7 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, * 1dc in next 2 dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc; repeat from * one more time, 1dc in next dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr. 1dc in next dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * one more time, 1dc in next dc, turn. (28 dc, 1 tr, 4 C-puff2)

Row 8 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * one more time, 1dc in next 2 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr.

1dc in next **2** dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * one more time, 1dc in next 2 dc, turn. (32 dc, 1 tr, 4 C-puff2)



Row 9 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in each st until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in each st to the end of the row, turn. (40 dc, 1 tr)

Row 10 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, * 1dc in next 2 dc, skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc; repeat from * until 1 dc before tr (corner), 1dc in next dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr.

1dc in next dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * until last dc, 1dc in next dc, turn. (38 dc, 1 tr, 6 C-puff2)

Row 11 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * until **2** dc before tr (corner), 1dc in next 2 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr.

1dc in next **2** dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * last **2** dc, 1dc in next 2 dc, turn. (42 dc, 1 tr, 6 C-puff2)

Row 12 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in each st until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in each st to the end of the row, turn. (52 dc, 1 tr)

Row 13 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in **flo** of each dc until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in **flo** of next tr, 1dc in **flo** of each dc to the end of the row, turn. (56 dc flo, 1 tr flo)

Section 1

With color B

Row 14 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, * skip next st, 1dc in next st, 1C-puff2 in skipped st; repeat from * until 1 dc before tr (corner), 1dc in next dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr.

1dc in next dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc; repeat from * until last dc, 1dc in next dc, turn. (34 dc, 1 tr, 26 C-puff2)



Row 15 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, * skip next st, 1dc in next st, 1C-puff2 in skipped st; repeat from * until 1 dc before tr (corner), 1dc in next dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr. 1dc in next dc, * skip next st, 1dc in next st, 1C-puff2 in skipped st; repeat from * until last dc, 1dc in next dc, turn. (36 dc, 1 tr, 28 C-puff2)

** In this row, the dc are worked into the dc and the C-puff2 into the C-puff2.



With color A

Row 16 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in each st until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr, 1dc in each st to the end of the row, turn. (68 dc, 1 tr)

Row 17 (WS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in **flo** each dc until tr (corner), [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next **flo** tr, 1dc in **flo** each dc to the end of the row, turn. (72 dc flo, 1 tr flo)

Row 18 (RS): STsc in 1st dc, 1dc in next **2** dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * until **3** dc before tr (corner), 1dc in next 3 dc, [2dc, 1tr-**PM**, 2dc] in next tr.

1dc in next **5** dc, * skip next dc, 1dc in next 3 dc, 1C-puff2 in skipped dc, 1dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * until last dc, 1dc in next dc, turn. (66 dc, 1 tr, 10 C-puff2)

Pattern Notes

- There's a chart after the written pattern.
- Ch3 at the beginning of the row counts as 1dc.
- The blanket is worked from one corner to corner (similar to the C2C method, but without the decreasing), you can make it as big as you'd like.
- Place marker in the corner stitch (tr) and move marker along the rows to make it easier to find the corner.
- This blanket need blocking to obtain its final shape, don't skip this step. Stitch counting:
- Each tulip row adds a total of 8 tulips (4 at each side).
- Each dc row adds a total of 4 dc (2 at each side). When working a dc row after a tulip row, you add a total of 8 dc in compared to the last dc row. Changing color:
- Every other tulip row you change a color.
- The table indicates which color is used in which row/section of the blanket.
- When changing color: at the last stitch of the roe, before changing color, start the stitch as normal, when you pull the yarn through the 2 loops to finish the stitch, wrap the new color around the hook and pull through.

Round 52 (same as round 14): Ss blo to next ch-1 (gap), ch1 (counts as sc blo), ch1, 1sc blo into same ch-1 gap.

* 1sc in each sc of one round below (round 50) until ch-1 gap, (1sc blo, ch1, 1sc blo) into ch-1 gap of previous round (round 51); repeat from * 3 times. 1sc in each 21 sc of one round below (last sc will be in last ss of of round 51), ss to first ch-1 of the round.

Round 53 (same as round 15): Ss blo to next ch-1 (gap), ch1 (counts as sc blo), ch2, 1sc blo into same ch-1 gap.

* [ch1, skip sc, 1sc blo in next sc] repeat [...] until last sc before ch-1 gap (corner), ch1, skip sc, (1sc blo, ch2, 1sc blo) into ch-1 gap; repeat from * 3 times. [Ch1, skip sc, 1sc blo in next sc] repeat [...] until last sc before ch-2 gap (corner), ch1, skip sc (ch-1), ss to ch-2.

Round 54-61: Repeat round 4.

With COLOR B Round 62: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR A Rounds 63-64: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR B Round 65: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR A Rounds 66-67: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR B Round 68: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR A Rounds 69-70: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR B Round 71: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR A Rounds 72-73: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR B Round 74: Repeat round 4.

WITH COLOR A Rounds 75-80: Repeat round 4.

Round 81: Ch1 (counts as sc blo), **ch1 (gap)**, 1sc blo in 3rd chain (the second of the ch-2 gap).

* **skip 1**st **st**, 1sc blo in each st (each sc and ch-1) until ch-2 gap, 1sc blo in 1st chain of ch-2 gap, ch1, 1sc blo in 2nd chain of ch-2 gap; repeat from * 3 times. **Skip 1**st **st**, 1sc blo in each st until corner, ss to first ch-1 of the round. Fasten off.

** Skipping the first st, prevents from the blanket to become "wavey".

Adding tassels

Using a mix of colors A and B yarns, cut 48 pieces (12 for each corner) measuring approx. 12.5 " (31 cm).

Fold the 12 pieces strands of yarn in half, using your hook pull the center of the yarn through ch-1 gap from the back side of the blanket. Remove the hook and pull the ends of the yarn through the small loop, tighten and make another knot to secure the tassel.



Yay you're done! Soak and block 😊

Waves of Grains Baby Blanket



Skill Level: Easy

<u>Materials</u>

- Crochet hook size: 5.50 mm / I
 (I used <u>Furls Streamline</u> hook)
- Worsted (#4) weight yarn (I used <u>Furls -</u> <u>Wander Acrylic- Thatch</u>)
 <u>Total amount of yarn needed:</u> 1,000gr/1,090m/1,200yds

Gauge (half double crochet):

15 sts and 8 rows = 4 in/10 cm with 5.5mm / I hook. Gauge is not crucial for this pattern.

Finished size:

35x35" (89x89cm)

Abbreviations (US)

ch - chain

hdc - half double crochet

- hdc2tog <u>half double crochet 2 together</u>: yo, insert hook into next st, yo and pull up a loop, yo, insert hook into next st, yo and pull up a loop, yo and pull through all 5 loops on hook.
 PM place marker
- Puff (yo, insert hook into indicated st, yo and pull up a loop)x3 times working into same st, yo & pull through all 7 loops on hook

SV-Spuff - side small V-puff: [1Spuff, ch1, 1hdc]

- Spuff <u>small puff</u>: (yo, insert hook into next st, yo & pull up a loop)x2 times working into same st, yo & pull through all 5 loops on hook st - stitch
- st stitch
- sc single crochet
- sp space
- V-hdc [1hdc, ch1, 1hdc] in same stitch
- V-puff [1puff, ch1, 1puff]
- yo yarn over

Pattern Notes

- To make it easier to find the ch3 / ch2 spaces at the end of the row, place a stitch marker when you ch3/ch2 at the beginning of each row.
- Every 3 rows, the V-puff's and V-hdc are being shifted.
- This blanket is based on my C2C V stitch pattern, you can find the photo tutorial on my <u>blog</u>.



How to crochet the puff stitch:

(yo, insert hook into next st, yo and pull up a loop) x 3 times working into same st, yo and pull through all 7 loops on hook.



How to crochet the small puff stitch (Spuff):

(yo, insert hook into next st, yo and pull up a loop) x 2 times working into same st, yo and pull through all 5 loops on hook.

Ch4 **Row 1:** V-hdc in 4th ch from hook, turn.

Row 2: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next st, SV-Spuff in ch-3 sp, turn.

puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp,



SV-Spuff in ch-3 sp, turn.





Row 4: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, V-hdc in ch-3 sp, turn.





Row 3: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-

Row 5: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp * Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to ch-3 sp, SV-Spuff in ch-3 sp, turn.

Row 6: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-puff in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to ch-3 sp, V-hdc in ch-3 sp, turn.

Row 7: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp. * Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to ch-3 sp, V-hdc in ch-3 sp, turn.



Row 8: repeat row 6.

Row 9: repeat row 7

Row 10: ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to ch-3 sp, SV-Spuff in ch-3 sp, turn.



Row 11: repeat row 7 Row 12: repeat row 10 Row 13: repeat row 5 **Row 14:** ch3-PM, skip 1st st, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to ch-3 sp, SV-Spuff in ch-3 sp, turn.

Row 15: repeat row 5


Row 16: repeat row 6

Repeat rows 5-16 until you reach 35" (89cm) or your desired length, finishing with row 16.

Decrease

Row 17: ch**2**-PM, skip 1st hdc, 1hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-puff (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-3 sp, turn.



Row 18: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-puff in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-hdc (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-hdc) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 19: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp. * Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to last V-puff (of prev. row), hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2 sp, turn.



Row 20: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & hdc, V-puff in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-puff (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 21: repeat row 19

Row 22: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & hdc, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to last V-puff (of prev. row), hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2, turn.

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Row 23: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & hdc, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-hdc (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-hdc) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 24: repeat row 22

Row 25: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & hdc, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-hdc (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-hdc) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 26: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-hdc (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-hdc) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 27: repeat row 25

Row 28: repeat row 18

Row 29: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp.

* Skip next 2 sts, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to **last V-puff (of prev. row)**, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Repeat rows 18-29 until you have only 3 V-sts (finishing with row 28) and continue to row 30.



Row 30: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 sts, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 31: ch2-PM, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, V-puff in next ch-1 sp, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-hdc) & ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 32: ch**1**, skip next hdc2tog & 1puff, hdc2tog in last ch-1 sp (of V-puff) & ch-2 sp. Do not fasten off.



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Border

Turn the blanket in 90 degrees.

Ch1 and start working 2sc in each side of each hdc and hdc2tog (you will be working 2sc in each row's side), continue working until corner, work corner: [1sc, ch1, 1sc] into the corner.

Continue working each side of the blanket.

On the last side of the blanket, when you reach the corner work corner: [1sc, ch1, 1sc] into the beginning ch-1, ss to 1st sc. Fasten off and weave in the ends.
